Beowulf	Black & Blueberry	4.5%	Black & Blueberry is a dark ale finished off with a judicious dose of blueberries.
Beowulf	Dark Raven	4.5%	Like Beowulf, Dark Raven has become a legend and is Beowulf's flagship dark ale. Headlining the renowned dark beers of Beowulf Brewery it is brewed using pale, black and crystal malts and hopped with Fuggles. It has a BIG smoked malt aroma with liquorice, espresso coffee, dark chocolate and burnt fruit. Bitter hops break through on the palate and finish with creamy coffee, dark fruit and roasted grain. Over the years it has won numerous awards and is a favourite of many – here to stay, forever!
Beowulf	Mango Sypian	4.3%	Mango Sypian (pronounced 'sippian') is the newest beer in the Beowulf range. Sypian translates as 'to sip or drink' in Old English. It has bursts of juicy mango, combined with a tropical hoppy aroma. This is a pale ale which is refreshing and moderately dry on the palate, with a smooth and delicately bitter finish.
Beowulf	Wulf	4.3%	Wulf is Beowulf Brewery's flagship pale ale. It headlines the pale ale selection from the brewery and is delightfully quaffable in taste, a true 'easy-drinker'. The name is obviously taken from the word Beowulf but the beer also uses Wolf hops - it was a match made in Beowulf folklore! This is a golden and hoppy pale ale with a hint of grapefruit and passionfruit - a proud, single-hop beer that is both crisp and refreshing.

Bewdley	Baldwin IPA	4.2%	A golden hoppy pale ale. Brewed with plenty of Summit, Columbus and Citra hops. Named after Stanley Baldwin, MP for Bewdley and three times Prime Minister.
Bewdley	Jubilee Ale	4.3%	A pale beer with a distinct sweetness and underlying hints of citrus with a fruity aroma.
Bewdley	Sunshine	3.8%	A very pale beer with sweetness, fresh, fruity, & citrus of the single hop Citra.
Bewdley	William Mucklows Dark Mild	6.0%	A dark, sweetish, strong Ale with smooth fruity flavour & slight Licorice after taste.
Bewdley	Worcestershire Sway	5.0%	A stronger version of Worcestershire Way. Still pale in colour with sweetness and a fruity finish.
Bewdley	Worcestershire Way	3.6%	Pale straw colour. First Gold, Celeia and Fuggles hops. A very refreshing session beer with citrus aftertones.
Brew 61	Golden Fleece	5.0%	A refreshingly crisp craft lager with malty undertones.
Brew 61	Grazing Girls	4.5%	Ride tropical fruitiness on the nose, with a big hoppy taste and a clean, light bitter finish.
Brew 61	Greenfields Gold	3.8%	A lovely light golden session IPA. A fresh citrus aroma is balanced with a light hoppy and malt taste and a subtle bitterness.
Brew 61	Hazy Bale	5.0%	A juicy, hazy IPA with a tropical hop aroma hit initial bitter taste and a smooth Citra and passion fruit finish.
Brew 61	Hop On	4.5%	A yellow Gold pale ale with a fresh and zesty aroma, followed up with a big hoppy citrus flavour and thirst-quenching bitterness.
Brew 61	Spring Meadow	4.3%	Inspired by the floral views and smells of a freshly mowed pasture. A yellow gold English pale ale. A clean, low to moderate bitterness, fruity hop sweetness with a slight peppery taste.
Burning Sky	Plateau	3.4%	Pale gold in colour, with a crisp malt edge and sharp bitterness. Plateau has been hopped at different stages of the brew, with a big mix of US & NZ hops to satisfy the discerning drinker. Full in flavour, zesty, refreshing & low in alcohol, this beer will have you returning to the bar for another.

Fresh Standard	Horse Brass	4.0%	A bitter named after a brass ornament, originally intended for the harness of a horse. Standard Bitter Fresh, amber ale with an aromatic malt flavour and crisp, hop bitter finish Brewed with four ingredients in a valley between three commons

Green Duck	Tongue Tied	4.6%	Pale Gold - Orange Aroma - Pine Flavour.
Hobsons	Olicana (Collab North Brewing)	5.0%	Punchy IPA - Tropical Fruits Flavours & Aroma.
Hop Back	Citra	4.0%	American Citra Hops - Lemony - Grapefruit - Dry Finish.
Hop Kettle	Element	4.2%	Triple hopped session pale. Late and dry hop additions of Mandarina Bavaria, Mosaic and Cascade hop varieties bring fresh, bright orange citrus and soft fruit flavours, with a smooth and clean bitterness in the finish.
Hop Kettle	Space Cowboy	4.7%	Roasted malt & coffee on the nose lead to a thick, velvety body with suitable sweetness balancing flavours of cacao, coffee & red berries.
Hop Shed	Frizzle	4.5%	A truly British IPA. Rich and golden with a floral hop aroma. A slight malty presence, followed by a significant hoppy bitterness from UK Cascade hops.
Hop Shed	Headless Chicken	4.2%	A single hopped IPA. Caramel malt gives an initial sweetness which is followed by a refreshing, gentle, citrusy bitterness from Emperor hops. A beer that takes your tastebuds on a journey!
Hop Shed	Hip Hop	3.4%	This is the 4th in a series of beers using new, pioneering trial hops grown by Charles Faram. CF321 works perfectly in this light, sessionable summer beer, giving light fruity notes and just a hint of bubble-gum!

Hop Shed	Pale	4.0%	All Hail the Pale! A trio of locally grown, new British hop varieties are showcased in this session pale ale. Easy drinking...tropical fruitiness...perfectly balanced. Ordinary name, extraordinary flavour!
Hop Shed	Sebright	3.8%	A straw-coloured ale with fruity hop aromas and flavours from Endeavour and First Gold hops. A quenching beer that appeals to lager drinkers as well as beer lovers.
Kelham Island	Pale Rider	5.2%	Fresh Citrus and Berries Nose - Juicy Malt Character.
Ludlow	Best	3.7%	Best is a well-balanced session ale with a golden amber complexion. The aroma of this ale is banana, pineapple and toffee and it has a resinous and dry finish.
Ludlow	Blonde	4.0%	Blonde has an initial sweetness which gives over to a heartily refreshing hop flavour, a result of using Citra, Cascade, Sladek and Goldings hops in the brew.
Ludlow	Ludlow Gold	4.2%	Their first beer brewed, now a firm favourite. A golden ale complexion with a papaya, pineapple and lemon aroma. Gold has a soft, full bodied and creamy taste.
Ludlow	Red Dawn	4.5%	Red Dawn is a refreshingly modern, hop-forward red ale using the finest Maris Otter barley and lightly toasted German malts. Citrus and pine aromas are followed by a smooth finish with little bitterness.
Ludlow	Stairway	5.0%	A honey gold complexion with a grassy, citrus-floral aroma and a sharp, sweet, full bodied taste. The unusual use of Sladek lager hops has built a cult following.

Magic Dragon	Hoppy Jester	4.5%	Tropical Aromas - Citrus Taste - Hoppy Flavour.

Stroud	Tom Long	3.8%	An ever popular amber session bitter. Full bodied, with caramel notes from crystal malt and a spicy orange aroma. Named after the mythical highwayman of Minchinhampton common.
Teme Valley	Cosmos	4.5%	A British lager using Archer hops.
Teme Valley	Hop to the Top	4.4%	A light golden summer ale using CF227 hops for fruity aromas.
Teme Valley	Talbot Blond	4.4%	A golden ale with zesty aromas from Ernest hops .
Teme Valley	That	4.1%	An old fashioned best bitter. Chestnut coloured with Sovereign hops.
Teme Valley	This	3.7%	An easy drinking pale ale with aroma from Goldings hops.
Three Tuns	XXX	4.3%	Premium Bitter - Light Malty Sweetness - Floral Character.
Titanic	Plum Porter	4.9%	Dark - Strong - Natural Plum Flavouring Porter.

TripleFFF	Altons Pride	3.8%	A traditional English bitter brewed using water from the Hampshire chalk hills. Full and clean tasting; initially malty, then tangerine fruit and resinous hop build to a quenching bitter finish. CAMRA Supreme Champion Beer of Britain 2008.
TripleFFF	Barbarian	4.7%	Not too sweet, not too hopped - natural carbonation in cask delivers "a beer drinker's lager" which is proving to be very popular. If you like Goldfffiner, you'll love Barbarian.
TripleFFF	Comfortably Numb	5.0%	This deep-amber-coloured ale contains a secret blend of malt and hops which gives a mouth-watering hop aroma, smooth and warming malt flavours and a deep, spicy hop finish.
TripleFFF	Fools Gold	5.4%	All-British Ingredients, a rich beer with a deep golden hue, hop forward and full-bodied with dry bitterness that lingers but is very more-ish.
TripleFFF	Jagged Little Pilsner	5.0%	Stunning pilsner, super pale - slight hint of watermelon.
TripleFFF	Pressed Rat & Warthog	3.8%	A complex mild, perhaps not in the traditional sense, as its quite hoppy. Ruby coloured, with coffee and chocolate aroma; hints of dried fruits and sour cherry leads to a soft, yet full roast flavour. Fruit and malt vying with the rounded hoppy bittersweet finish. Not only for the mild fanatics but the bitter lovers too. Both will be left satisfied and wanting more.
TripleFFF	Sundown	4.3%	A Golden IPA with mild Citra coming through at the end – originally named "Coronation" but as it sold out 3 weeks before King Charles's Coronation it was relaunched as "Sundown" - here to stay!
TripleFFF	We'll Meet Again	3.8%	A well-hoped pale ale. Fruit forward (nectaron hop combined with long conditioning) with a refreshing bitterness at the end. The pump clip commemorates service people past and present and thank them for keeping us safe.
Vale	Good Day Sunshine	4.0%	Refreshing - Crisp - Easy Drinking.
Wye Valley	Butty Bach	4.5%	Butty Bach is a Welsh term meaning 'little friend' – and this charmingly smooth premium ale has certainly made more than a few friendships in its time. Brewed using Maris Otter and Crystal malts together with locally grown Fuggles, Goldings and Bramling Cross hops. With such fine ingredients, no wonder it remains a firm favourite.

Wye Valley	HPA	4.0%	HPA is an easy-going real ale that brings people together. Locally grown Target and Celeia hops hang out with Maris Otter pale malt to give this understated brew its pale straw colour, citrus hop aroma and a balanced bitter finish.
Wye Valley	The Hopfather	3.9%	Mosaic, Summit, Cascade, Pilot and Azacca hops join forces to give some seriously hoppy clout. This session IPA also boasts a new vibrant gold colour together with subtle malt overtones, zesty fruit flavours and a refreshingly crisp finish. Hats off to a top brew!
Wye Valley	Bitter	3.7%	This chestnut-coloured wonder is a mouthwatering example of a cask-conditioned bitter. Brewed using Maris Otter and Crystal malts together with locally grown Target and Goldings hops, it has a delicate hoppy aroma leading on to a full malty flavour and ending in a crisp, clean bitter finish.
